As a charity we must comply with UK law and safeguard everyone who comes in to contact with the organisation.

Existing laws are too weak, and the climate and ecological crises are not being taken seriously. These are not isolated issues and their solutions mustn't be either. It is time to stop the damage and turn the situation around. We believe that:

- Everyone must come together to help wildlife thrive at the scale and pace required;
- Action on the interlinked climate and nature crises must be accelerated;
- It is not acceptable to continue showing a lack of respect for the natural world, for example permitting damaging development in designated protected spaces;
- We need new laws that truly give nature and people alike a safe and healthy future.

While we recognise that radical activism and planned disruption can have impact, we're aware that not everyone wants to or is in a position to take this route.
